

Race Rules

1. The Driver of Record is responsible for all people on their team and in their pits.
2. Entrants, pit crew members, volunteers and family waive any claim they may have against MORE, it's officials and BLM when voluntarily participating in MORE events.
3. **NO Alcohol in the pits during all races. Immediate Disqualification will result.**
4. **All race teams must have a Pit Boss**, this Pit Boss must attend the driver's meeting and receive a special wristband after the meeting. Race teams without a pit boss will be DQ'd.
5. **RV's, Toyhaulers, and race trailers must be a minimum of 150' off the race course.** This setback at main pit is marked by yellow flags, everything behind the yellow flags is considered the **Cold Pit**.
6. Your Hot Pit is a 25' zone that is 25' in front of your cold pit making an emergency lane in-between your **Hot Pit** and **Cold Pit** that will be used by MORE and BLM Monitors. **This lane must be kept clear of pit equipment.** (cords and hoses are permitted in the emergency lane)
7. **No RV's, enclosed trailers, or box vans are permitted in the Hot Pit.** Only 1 flatbed trailer or 1 Chase/Pit Truck are permitted in a team's **Hot Pit**.
8. **No one under the age of 14 is permitted to be in the Hot Pit area at main or at any other designated pit.** This means they are also not allowed to have a Pit Pass Armband! Only Pit Crew Members working on the race vehicles should have armbands! DQ will result!
9. **All Pit Crew Personnel are required to have Hi-Vis vests or shirts.** This is mandatory at all pits.
10. Mobile/Chase pits are permitted at any safe spot 150' off the race course. Mobile pits must remain mobile leaving all pit equipment in the vehicle until repairs are being made.
11. **Fuel Containment must be used.** Absorbent material must be placed under drums fuel cans at all times.
12. **Speed Limit through Main Pit, outlying pits, and all road crossings is 50mph. Infractions will result in time held at Start/Finish during the race.**
13. Speed zones are marked by yellow flags at the start of the zone, and green flags at the end of the zone. You must slow down to 50mph before you cross any yellow flags and remain at 50mph until you cross the green flags. Speeding penalties will be served during the race at Start/Finish.
14. The race groove at Main Pit is marked with white poles with orange tips. You are to remain in this groove until you are within 300 feet of your pit. When you leave your pit you are to get back in the race groove within 300 feet. When you are outside of the main pit race groove the speed limit is 35 mph.
15. **Road crossings that come within 150' of a powerline tower or pole are 25mph zones. These zones will be marked accordingly.**
16. Absolutely no passing through road crossings and no aggressive passing through pit speed zones.
17. Speed Limit is **15mph** anytime you come within 50 feet of people on the race course.
18. **You may leave the race course and return to a pit to perform repairs on your vehicle, however you may never travel backwards on the race course, and you must also return to the race course where you left it to complete your lap. DO NOT leave your pit and go through Start/Finish an additional time!**
19. You must come to a complete stop at Start/Finish every lap.
20. If you have a problem during the race it is imperative that you get off the race course as much as possible.
21. Race staging begins 20 minutes prior to race start. If you are late you will loose your starting position.
22. Please report any spectators that are too close to the race course to MORE Relay: 151.715.
23. **All nerfing incidents need to be reported to Start/Finish by the end of the race.**
24. **Course cutting will result in disqualification from the race and the points championship.**
